Dear Feldbahn friends,

Stoomtrein Katwijk Leiden cordially invites you to the 30th International Feldbahntreffen. The program consists of a preliminary program from October 5 to October 8, 2020, followed by the main program from October 9 to October 11.

In the preliminary program we will introduce you to the narrow gauge scene in the Netherlands. We will visit the most important narrow-gauge museums, in Ouddorp, Heteren, Rijssen and Erica. Included in the preliminary program are 2 lunches, 2 dinners and 2 overnight stays. Further information about the participating organisations is included in the attachment. Participation to the preliminary program is limited to a maximum of 50 people.

The main program starts on Friday, October 9. During the main program and outside the formal parts of the program you are welcome to drive the equipment of the Stoomtrein Katwijk Leiden yourself. The Main Program will end on Sunday with a visit to the Louwman Museum in The Hague. The Louwman Museum houses the world's oldest private collection of automobiles. The car collection, brought together by two generations of the Louwman family, shows the history of the automobile. More than 250 cars from more than 100 manufacturers.

The costs for the preliminary program are € 400.00 per person all-in, unless stated otherwise in the program.

The costs for the main program are € 125.00 per person. The costs include dinner on Friday, lunch and dinner on Saturday.

There are good accommodation options in the vicinity of the museum. Attached you will find a list of hotels. For reservations, you will need to contact the accommodation of your choice yourself.

Preliminary Program of the International Field Railway Meeting 2020

Sunday, October 4th 2020

Reception at the museum of the [Stoomtrein Katwijk Leiden](#) at Valkenburg near Leiden

Monday, October 5th

Visit to the Narrow Gauge Island Railway ([RTM-museum](#)) at Ouddorp (1067 mm)

Lunch (on your own account).



The small train on the Brouwersdam tells the history of the 'Rotterdamsche Tramweg Maatschappij', once the largest transport company in the region. The RTM Museum has an excellent collection of steam and diesel locomotives that are still being used. Walk around in the shed and take a look at the old post car and also the only remaining camping car.

Next is a visit to the Delta Works ([Deltapark Neeltje Jans](#))

Deltapark Neeltje Jans is located at the foot of the world's largest storm surge system. What is the story of this immense structure? In the Delta Experience



you can experience the historical events of the struggle of the Netherlands with the water in an innovative, accessible and lively way.

Dinner and overnight stay in Leiden (on your own account).

Tuesday, October 6th

Visit to the Dutch national railway museum, [Spoorwegmuseum](#) Utrecht

Lunch on your own account.



The afternoon features a visit to the field railway museum [Gelders Smalspoor Museum](#) (700mm) at Heteren.

Narrow gauge was used here until the 1990s. For a while, a locomotive from the GSS collection was even loaned to this brick factory. The 700 mm track on which the clay was dumped into the sorting and molding system was even there! A drying room is now set up as an indoor



museum and reception area. A second drying room was set up as a locomotive and wagon shed. Furthermore, of course, *new tracks* have been laid in recent years, which has been used for several years on operational days. Plans for additional storage, an expanded main track (700 mm) and a 600 mm gauge track are also being worked on.

Next we will leave for Rijssen, where an evening buffet is offered at the Rijssens Leemspoor. The overnight stay takes place in a hotel near the narrow gauge museum at Rijssen.

Wednesday, October 7th

In the morning: driving program at field railway of the [Rijssens Leemspoor](#) (600 mm)
With packed lunch.



In Rijssen, at the foot of the Rijsserberg, there is a narrow-gauge railway on which the brick factory transported its raw materials around 100 years ago. The vehicle collection consists among other things of a steam locomotive, various diesel locomotives, passenger, freight and work trains. In the shed you can see how far the restoration of the vehicle has progressed.

In the afternoon: visit to the 700 mm line of the brick factory museum [de Werklust Losser](#)



In the evening reception at the Erica field railway museum with dinner. Overnight stay in a hotel next to the field railway.

Thursday October 8th

Program with driving at the narrow gauge field railway museum ([Industrieel SmalSpoormuseum](#)) at Erica (700/900 mm)

With packed lunch.



The Industrieel SmalSpoormuseum in Erica gives an account of how the field railways were used during the industrial development of the Netherlands in the previous century. A journey of just over an hour on the historic field train, a tour of the peat mill factory, the museum and the museum grounds will be an unforgettable experience for every visitor in a unique area.

In the afternoon visit to the [Mechanisch Erfgoed Centrum](#) at Dronten

Enter the 19th century at the Mechanical Heritage Center in Dronten. A museum with great diversity. You will literally encounter all kinds of objects, from sewing machines and tools to large steam engines and historic combustion engines, including a collection of Moës locomotives.

Dinner and overnight stay (on your own account) in Leiden.
